Championship Rules and Regulations

1. Event Categories

2. The 5th Uganda International Open Woodball Championship shall have the following Stroke Competition events:

a. Open Team Event (Men and Women)

Each team consists of 4 players for the Team Event. The sum of the players' scores of the Stroke Preliminary Competition of 24 fairways will be counted as the team score. The Team which has the least number of strokes is the winning team.

b. Youth Team Event (Men and Women)

Result shall be based on total best score of four (4) players in 12 gates.

c. Open Singles Event (Men and Women)

The top 12 players of men and women from the preliminary round of 24 fairways will be eligible to play in the final, a second 24-fairway round. The sum strokes of 48 fairways from preliminary, and the Final will be added up for the eligibility of the winner. Any player who scores the least strokes is the winner.

d. Youth Singles Event (Men and Women)

Result shall be based on the 12 gates played by the individual

e. Open Doubles Event (Men, Women and Mixed)

The Doubles events, competitors take turns in striking the ball. Male and Female players whose names listed first on the registration roster should strike first in the odd-numbered fairways, and the other players should strike first in the even-

numbered fairways. After completing the competition of 24 fairways, the sum of strokes will be the Doubles final score.

3. General Rules and Regulations

- a. It is compulsory for all players, participants and registered team officials to display the issued accreditation cards.
- b. The most recent IWbF enacted Woodball Rules and Regulations shall be applied unless specified by the organizer.
- c. Tournament rules shall be announced during the Team leaders meeting.
- d. Woodball equipment to be used must confirm to the IWbF specifications.
- e. All participants must comply with the proper dress code: tucked-in T-shirt with collar, long pants or smart or smart short and sports shoes. Referees are authorized to enforce the dress code, non-compliance shall lead to disqualification and the referee's decision is final.
- f. Competition score cards must be signed by respective players and counter signed by referees before submission to the secretariat after completion of 12 gates.
- g. Tournament referee decision shall be final based on the following findings: line judge's statement, score marking clarification and interpretation of rules and regulations.
- h. Any dispute or appeal must be officially submitted to the technical counter with a fee of USD 100 within one (1) hour of the end of the competition played. The decision of the arbitration committee shall be final.
- i. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to change the format of competition if the situation is warranted due to unforeseen circumstances.

4. Prizes

A. Competitions

- a) Prizes will be determined based on the number of registered participants:
 - i. 1 player/team will be awarded when 3 or less players/teams register
 - ii. 2 players/teams will be awarded when 4 to 5 players/teams register
 - iii. 3 players/teams will be awarded when 6 or more players/teams register
- b) Winners of single and double events will be awarded a certificate and a medal. Winners of Team events will be awarded a certificate, a medal and a trophy.

B. Gate-in-One

Applicable to all Singles Stroke events, whoever hits the ball through the gate by 1 stroke will be awarded a medal and cash award of USD 100. If there is more than 1 such competitor, the prize money will be shared equally among them all.

C. International Tour Championship Ranking

For Singles Stroke Competition, the top 30 male and female competitors will receive points calculated based on the rules of the International Tour Woodball Championship, and the points will be accumulated with other winning points.

5. Entry

Please submit the Registration Form, Participation Form, Registration Fee, Participation Fee and photos of participants to the Organizing Committee before May 31, 2017.

Registration, Competition Fee, Tour and Accommodation Package

A. Registration Fee: Each member of the delegation is required to pay USD 10.

B. Sanction Fee: USD 5 per player for IWbF

C. Competition Fee:

- i. Team Event: **USD 50.00** per team of 4 – 6 players (Men and Women separate)
- ii. Singles Event: **USD 20.00** per participant
- iii. Doubles Event: **USD 30.00** per pair

D. Accommodation package (5 days 4 nights):

USD 250.00 per head covering hotel, airport transfer, 4 breakfasts at Central Inn, 3 lunches at competition venue and 2 official dinners (Opening and Closing)

All participants shall be accommodated at Central Inn Hotel, Entebbe. The hotel is 3 km from the International Airport and 3 km from the Competition venue.
